

# ERENKÖY MEHMET SAİT AYDOSLU MIDDLE SCHOOL



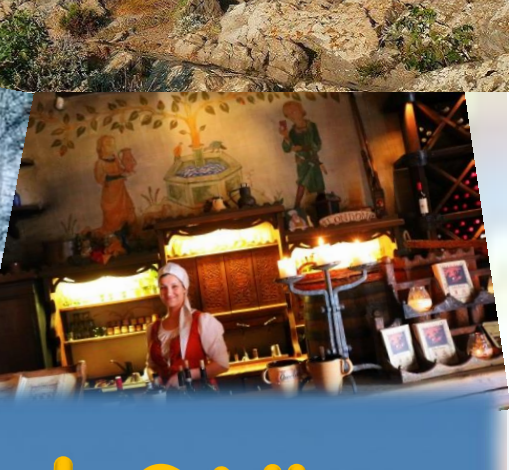
Our school founded in 1891. In those time, they called our school 38th School because it was 38th school in Istanbul.

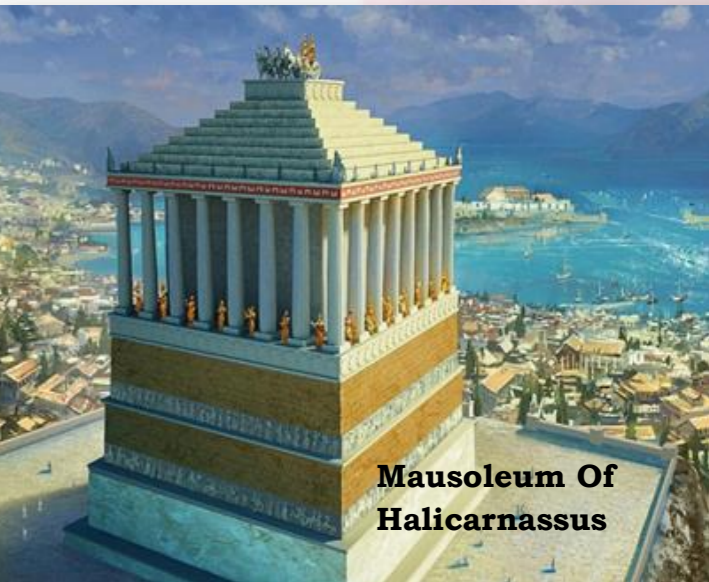
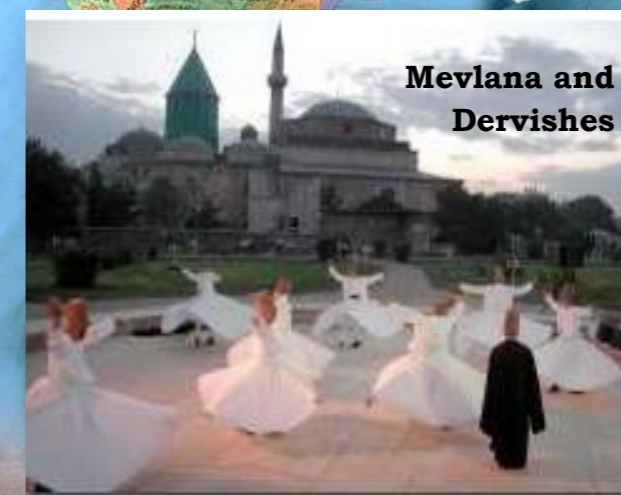


## The Story Of Turkish Flag

Mustafa Kemal Ataturk was a revolutionary who helped establish the Republic of Turkey. He was Turkey's first president, and his reforms modernized the country. Mustafa Kemal Ataturk was born in 1881 in the former Ottoman Empire.

As a young man, he was involved with the Young Turks, a revolutionary group that deposed the sultan in 1909.

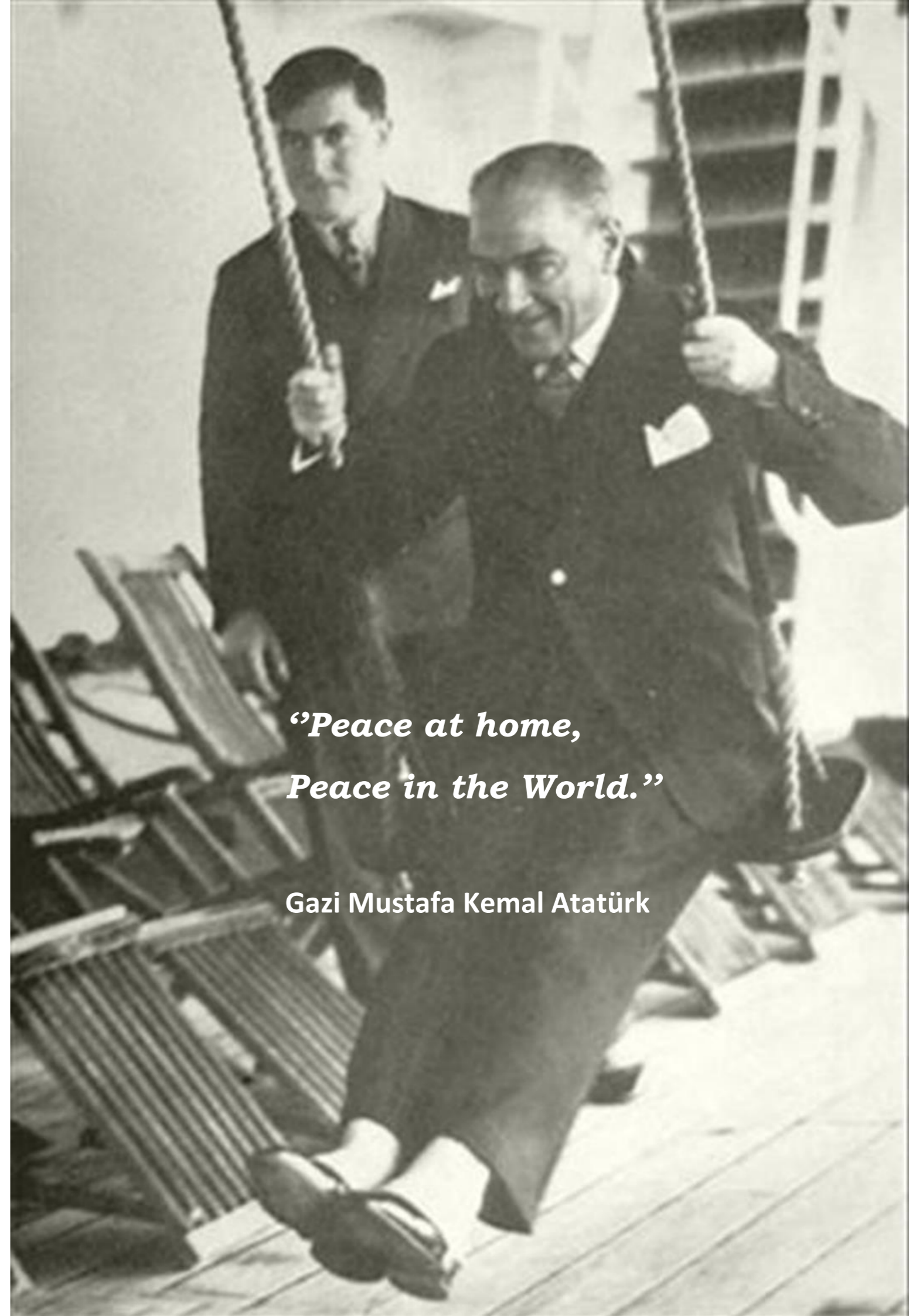
Ataturk led the Turkish War of Independence and signed the Treaty of Lausanne in 1923, which made Turkey a republic.

He was elected its first president and ushered in reforms that modernized Turkey.

He died in 1938.
